

STEP RIGHT UP

Ladder Shelving

Climb the ladder of style (and store more) with a repurposed wood ladder painted in a pretty pastel with lots of pop.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Cabinet, Door & Trim paint	Paint tray and liners
Wooden ladder	Fine- to medium-grit sandpaper
Flat paintbrush	Clean, damp cloth

Here's How:

Step 1 Use sandpaper to sand any rough or glossy surfaces on the ladder; wipe with the clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris.

Step 2 Use the flat brush to paint the ladder, focusing on a smooth, even application; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on the can label.

Optional: Apply a second coat of paint for added coverage.

Tip: Try two or more colors and paint steps a different color than the frame, or paint each step an increasingly darker shade to create an ombré effect.

Step 3 Secure ladder in place for added stability.
