Dutch Boy® Maxbond® exterior paint Angled paintbrush

Paint pail

Fine- to medium-grit sandpaper

Level

Hammer

Finishing nails

Drop cloth

Clean, damp cloth

Here's How:

- **Step 1** Remove shutters and transfer to an area covered with a drop cloth for painting.
- **Step 2** Prep the shutters by lightly sanding any rough or glossy surfaces.
- **Step 3** Wipe with a clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris and let dry.
- **Step 4** Pour paint into pail.
- **Step 5** Using an angled paintbrush, paint the shutters, starting with the center panel and working outward to the edges. Apply evenly so paint doesn't build up in the corners.
- **Step 6** Allow paint to dry completely. Follow suggested dry time on the can label. *Optional: Apply a second coat of paint for added durability.*
- **Step 7** Using a hammer and finishing nails, reinstall newly painted shutters to house.
- **Step 8** Add your personal touches to the space, like decorative pillows, hanging planters, and fun decor!
