

STEP ON IT!

Faux Porch Rug

Make a welcoming statement with the graphic impact of a colorful faux rug on your porch or patio.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Porch & Floor paint	Tape measure
Woven roller cover and roller frame	Level
Paint tray and liners	Pencil
Painter's tape	Clean, damp cloth

Here's How:

-
- Step 1** After thoroughly cleaning your porch or patio surface, use clean, damp cloth to remove all dust and debris.
- Step 2** Determine the location and size of the painted rug; use painter's tape and tape off the rug's outer edge; apply pressure to tape to ensure a tight seal.
- Step 3** Determine the position of the rug accent border by starting at the taped outer edge, measuring inward equally on all four sides and lightly making marks with the pencil; use the level to draw lines connecting the accent border; affix painter's tape to the inside edge and apply pressure to tape to ensure a tight seal.
- Tip: The width of the accent border is determined by the width of the painter's tape; for a narrow accent border, use a narrow painter's tape.*
- Step 4** Use the woven roller to paint within the taped areas.
- Optional: Add a second coat of paint for added durability.*
- Step 5** Remove painter's tape while paint is still damp; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on paint can label.
