

THINK INSIDE THE BOX

Painted Thinking—Space Accent

Create a room within a room by painting a wall accent to define your designated workspace.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Platinum® Plus paint (2 colors)	Tape measure
Woven roller covers and roller frame	Pencil
Angled paintbrush	Level
Paint tray and liners	Drop cloth
Painter's tape	Clean, damp cloth

Here's How:

-
- Step 1** Wipe wall with the clean, damp cloth to prepare painting surface.
 - Step 2** Lay down the drop cloth to protect floors; use painter's tape to cover trim, molding and ceiling.
 - Step 3** Using the angled brush, apply base color to walls just inside taped areas, then paint remaining area with the woven roller; remove painter's tape while paint is still damp; allow paint to dry 24 hours.
 - Step 4** Decide the size of the accent area; use the level and the pencil to lightly mark the vertical and horizontal lines of the accent area.
 - Step 5** Affix painter's tape to the outside of the pencil marks, pressing firmly to create a tight seal with the wall.
 - Step 6** Use the woven roller and angled brush to paint accent color inside the taped lines.
 - Step 7** Remove painter's tape while paint is still damp; clean up any mistakes with the clean, damp cloth; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on the can label.
