Colorful Butterfly Garland

Add a touch of whimsy to her décor with this kid-created butterfly garland.

You'll Need:

Construction paper	String
Crayola® Watercolor Paint	Tape
Scissors	Tacks

Here's How:

- Step 1** Draw the outline of a butterfly (approximately 3 inches across is a good size) on construction paper.
- Step 2** Cut out butterfly and use it as an outline for more butterflies.
- Step 3** Trace and cut out all butterflies.
- Step 4** Use Crayola® watercolors to decorate.
- Step 5** Tape string to the back of each butterfly, placing each one about 6 inches apart.
- Step 6** Hang with decorative tape or tacks.
