Empty Frame Gallery

Create a textured, tone-on-tone wallscape made from mismatched frames painted the same color as the wall they adorn.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Platinum® Plus paint	Fine-grit sandpaper
Assorted paintable picture frames	Hammer
Flat paintbrush	Nails
Paint tray and liners	Clean, damp cloth
Painter's tape	

Here's How:

- Step 1** Select a paint color identical to your wall color, or repaint the wall to match frames.
- Step 2** Prep frames by lightly sanding them; wipe with clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris.
Tip: To reduce prep time, use ready-to-paint frames.
- Step 3** Paint frames using the flat brush, being careful to coat edges and carved details; allow to dry, following suggested drying time on the can label.
Optional: Frames may require a second coat of paint.
- Step 4** Hang finished picture frames on the wall.
Tip: Trace frames on kraft paper. Cut and use paper pieces and painter's tape to plot gallery on the wall.
