## Window Shutter Mail Station

Give new purpose to a wooden shutter by converting it into a stylish organizer for incoming and outgoing mail.

### You'll Need:

---

Dutch Boy® Cabinet, Door & Trim paint	Paint tray and liners
Wooden window shutter	Fine- to medium-grit sandpaper
Picture hanging kit (with D-Rings and wire)	Hammer
Flat paintbrush	Nails
	Clean, damp cloth

### Here's How:

- 
- Step 1** Prep shutter by lightly sanding any rough or glossy surfaces; wipe with clean, damp cloth to remove dust or debris.
- Step 2** Using the flat brush, paint the shutter, being careful to apply evenly in between the slats; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on the can label.
- Optional: Apply a second coat of paint for added durability.*
- Step 3** If needed, fasten picture-hanging hardware to the back of the shutter, according to the instructions supplied in the kit.
- Step 4** Hang finished shutter on the wall.
