

MAKE A SPLASH

Painted Backsplash

Give your backsplash scene-stealing luster with a stunning (and scrubbable!) semi-gloss finish that will make your kitchen look sleek and polished.

You'll Need:

Dutch Boy® Platinum® Plus paint in semi-gloss finish	Painter's tape
Angled paintbrush	Level
Mini woven roller cover and roller frame	Pencil
Mini trays	Drop cloth
	Clean, damp cloth

Here's How:

-
- Step 1** Wipe wall with clean, damp cloth to prepare painting surface.
- Step 2** Cover your stove and counters with the drop cloth; use painter's tape to cover edges of cabinets and countertops.
- Step 3** Determine how far you'd like the backsplash area to extend; use the level and pencil to lightly mark the boundaries.
- Step 4** Using the angled brush, apply paint just inside taped areas and then paint the remaining area with the mini woven roller.
- Step 5** Remove painter's tape while paint is still damp; clean up any mistakes with the clean, damp cloth; allow paint to dry, following suggested drying time on paint can label.
